<b>POLICE</b>	<p><b>DRUG USE</b>-9 CRIME REPORTS- ALL RELATE TO POSSESSION OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES, ALL REPORTED TO PROCURATOR FISCAL.</p> <p><b>VIOLENT CRIME</b>-10 REPORTS OF VIOLENT CRIME, 2 SERIOUS ASSAULTS, 7 COMMON ASSAULTS, 1 SEXUAL ASSAULT. BOTH SERIOUS ASSAULTS BEING INVESTIGATED HOWEVER SUSPECTS ARE KNOWN TO VICTIMS.SEXUAL ASSAULT HAS BEEN DETECTED AND REPORTED TO PROCURATOR FISCAL. VICTIM AND OFFENDER ARE KNOWN TO EACH OTHER.</p> <p><b>YOUTHS CAUSING NUISANCE</b>- 10 CALLS TO POLICE- INCLUDES LOITERING IN STREET, DRINKING, THROWING STONES- POLICE HAVE ATTENDED AND ARE WORKING CLOSELY WITH THE NGHAI IN IDENTIFYING AND ISSUING WARNINGS TO TENANTS AND THEIR CHILDREN. THE CRIME TEAM CONTINUE TO WORK IN IDENTIFYING OFFENDERS OF CRIME OF DISHONESTY AND HAVE REPORTED SEVERAL TO THE PROCURATOR FISCAL.
