TREASURER REPORT; £1778.68

DAVID PEARSON; Director from Star Refrigeration- funding from Scottish Government. Building a cabin to house equipment to pump water from the Clyde through refrigeration to heat sports centre, Adelphi Centre and high flats. Due to be completed September 2018. Comments- will it be noisy as very close to properties.

COUNCILLORS REPORT; M Hunter- now chair of Health and Social Care has been doing visits within the remit.

Discussions taking place about school provision for Gorbals and Govanhill, also need to look at early years provision- questions asked about secondary school- this may be looked at later. Parking issues remain.

Cllr Belic- looking to put bike provision at Holyrood secondary. Need for back to school bank for used school uniforms.
