Minutes of last meeting; J McManus & S Chase propose and second minutes

Police; from December approx. 120 crimes in whole of Gorbals, no breakdown for Hutchesontown. 60-70% detection rate. 40 disorder, violent crimes. Attempted murder in Hutchesontown Court- all involved caught, concern from members about the rise in crime in area.

Treasurer's Report; in bank £1424, late e-mail to say £406 from resource centre for admin grant. Looking for ideas- will need monies for consultation, perhaps noticeboard.

NHS: Lisa & Hamish talk about new medical centre, outlining plans for parking- 4 zones 80 spaces, staffing spaces will be for services not individual names. Doctors on call will be parked at front of building. Community benefits will provide placements, apprentices, jobs. Construction traffic will be routed on to Laurieston Road. Business case at last stages of approval with Scottish Government, hopefully on site Feb.

Zander Planning; old castle site at Caledonia Road, site for development, pre planning stage. Looking to develop site mixture of residential and retail, outline application march/april, reports needed for noise and air quality. Residential- mix of social/private, midmarket rent.

Scott Chase; attended get Glasgow moving meetings, looking to improve infrastructure for transport, more info on website, will keep us updated.

Cllr Hunter; spoke to LES about bins that had been removed, pavement at Errol Gardens not fixed properly

CLlr Siddique; reported bins, weeds, blocked drainsholes in road at Cumberland Street, parking issues, bins at Southern Necropolis, dog fouling
